# SOR 3 Overview:

- To build an Integrated Behavioral Health System Continuum of Care for individuals with OUD, stimulant use disorder and Co-Occurring Disorders.
- The aim is to build on a community system of care (prevention, early intervention, treatment and recovery support) that emphasizes service integration between physical health, emergency health care, behavioral health care, criminal justice and child welfare.

# Eligibility



## SOR 3.0

- Individuals meet the following requirements:
  - Opiate misuse or use disorder  
**OR**
  - Stimulant misuse or use disorder
  - Franklin county resident
  - No other payer
- Prevention activities
  - FC resident
  - No other payer

# SOR 3 Overview: Reporting



- Government Performance and Results Act (GPRA)
  - Assessment occurs at intake, 6 month Follow-up and Discharge
  - Achieve 80% GPRA compliance of the evaluative services provided by an independently selected college or university. OhioMHAS will provide additional details once the evaluator is selected
- Prevention Tool
- Monthly Data Reporting
- Quarterly Fiscal Reporting

# SOR 3 Proposal Process

- RFP released 07.13.22
- Application Due Date: 08.03.22 at 12pm
- Proposals should be sent to [RFRSubmission@adamhfranklin.org](mailto:RFRSubmission@adamhfranklin.org)
- Applications must be submitted as two files: a single PDF for the program narrative and the original Excel worksheet for the budget and budget narrative.



# SOR 3 Proposal Process

- Notice of Award: TBA, **Notification of awards sent out, pending OhioMHAS approval and guidance**
- First Time Applicants, maximum \$200K budget per year
- Current SOR awardees need to apply for SOR 3 and will not automatically be renewed
- Anticipated Project Start Date: 09.30.22
- Project Period: 2 years

# Application

- Staffing/subject matter expertise
  - Detailed position descriptions that include the name and title of the person providing service
  - **Personnel expenses should align to staff duties allocated to SOR**

# Application

- Logic model/timeline
  - Template on online
  - 2 year grant plan
  - Include
    - start up time (hiring, training) implementation and close out of grant.



# Application

- Budget and budget narrative
  - Year 1 and Year 2 required
  - Column B: Line item Cost
  - Column C: narrative or detailed break down of the cost
    - IE: Rent 12,000 (\$1000 a month X 12 months)
