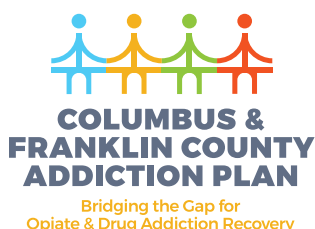
Walk In for Recovery Resource Fair • noon-6 p.m.
